

# Unique Duties and Opportunities



*Dedicated Airmen are needed to fill aircrew positions and serve on the leading edge of Air Force operations...*

*Gated flight pay based on years of aviation service*  
0-4 Years = \$150                      4-8 Years = \$225  
8-14 Years = \$350                  More than 14 Years = \$400  
*Flight pay continues during non-flying aircrew positions*



## AFSC: 1A0X0 In-Flight Refueling Specialist

The boom operator refuels aircraft In-flight; calculates weight & balance. Provides for the safety and comfort of passengers and troops; security of cargo and baggage during flight. Assists the pilots with aircraft operation and navigation.



## AFSC: 1A1X1B Flight Engineer - Helicopter

Operates helicopter systems; calculates performance and weight & balance data; advises and assist the pilots with in-flight duties. May perform Aerial Gunner Duties



## AFSC: 1A1X1C Flight Engineer Fixed Wing

Operates aircraft systems; calculates performance and weight & balance data; monitors aircraft systems operation and advises and assist the pilots with emergency corrective actions.

## AFSC: 1A2X1 Loadmaster

Supervises loading and offloading operations; responsible for the safety and comfort of passengers and troops during flight; prepares and rigs equipment for airdrop; conducts airdrop of equipment, supplies, and personnel.



## AFSC: 1A3X1 Airborne Communications and Electronics Specialist

Operates airborne transmitting/receiving equipment to conduct air-to-air and air-to-ground communications; and operates airborne electronic reconnaissance equipment.



## AFSC: 1A4X1 Airborne Battle Management Systems Specialist

Operates airborne sensor systems to detect, acquire and track airborne, maritime, and ground objects. Employs electronic warfare (EW) and electronic support measures (ESM) procedures.

**AFSC: 1A4X1D**

**Airborne Battle Management Specialist/Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS) Weapons Director**

Performs sensor-assisted control activities from on-board AWACS to direct engagements by manned air weapons; determines and employs various intercept or engagement tactics.



**AFSC: 1A5X1**

**Airborne Mission Systems Specialist**

Operates, monitors, inspects, tests, maintains, and evaluates surveillance radar, computer, display, and ancillary systems and equipment; monitors and manages airborne mission systems operation.



**AFSC: 1A6X1**

**Flight Attendant**

Plans, coordinates, and manages flight attendant and related duties; provides for passenger comfort and safety; performs aircrew functions.

**AFSC: 1A7X1  
Aerial Gunner**

Inspects, operates, and secures armament systems; performs aircrew functions concerning airborne weapons systems, procedures, and tactics.



**AFSC: 1A8X1X**

**Airborne Cryptologic Linguist**

Performs and supervises acquisition, recording, transcribing, translating, analyzing, and reporting of assigned voice communications onboard various aircraft platforms.
